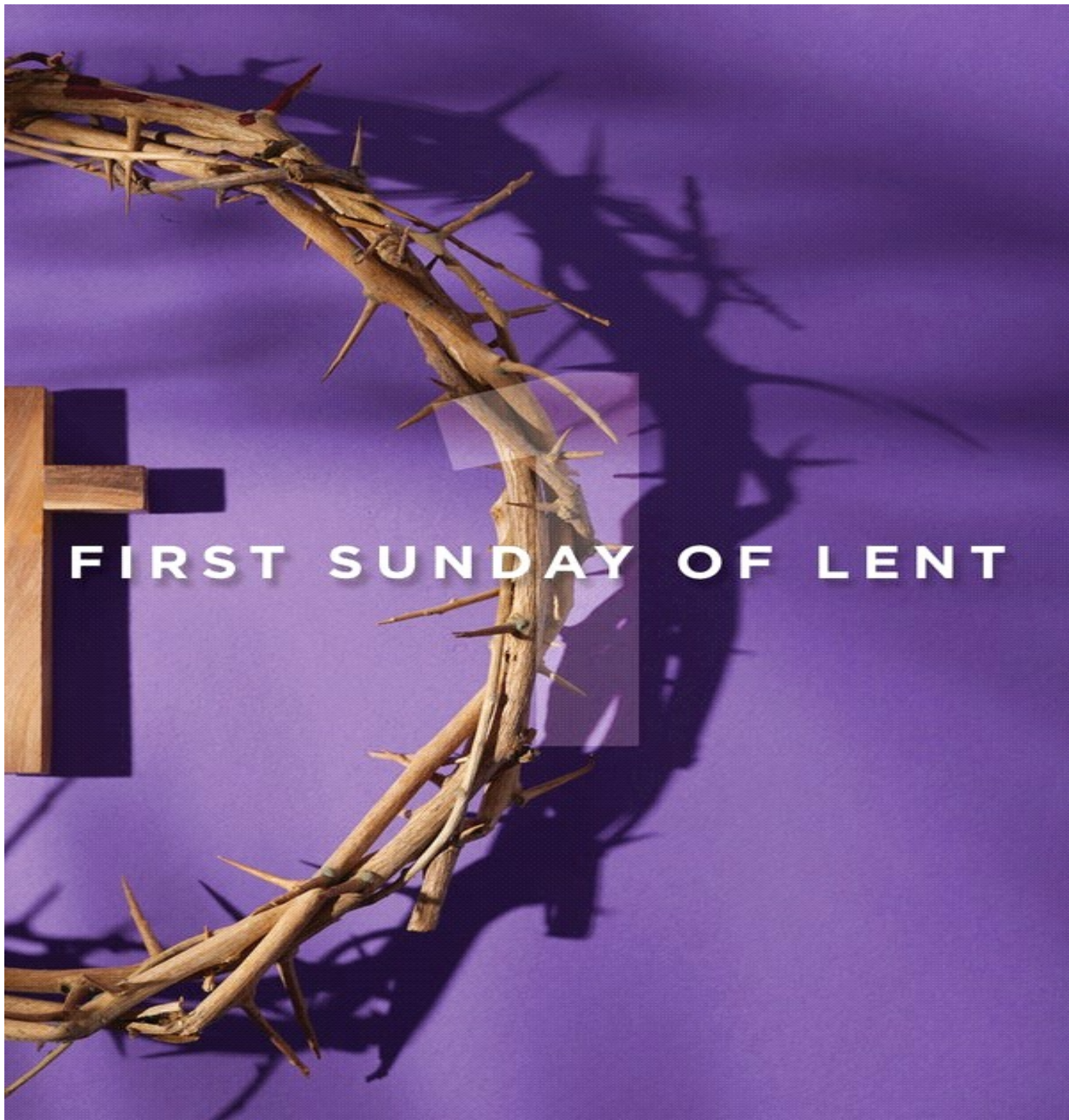

## Bishop's Appeal

**Individual and Family Counseling Services**, including mental health counseling for families, couples, and children.

**Family Strengthening Services** to refugee and immigration communities throughout northeastern Wisconsin.

**Adoption & Pregnancy Support Services** to assist birth parents, adoptive couples and people with unplanned pregnancies.

**Financial Health Services** offers tools and guidance to help people learn responsible financial management. *In 2023, the Bishop's Appeal distributed \$1,367,867 to Catholic Charities to support their ministries.*

During this Lenten season, we will again be collecting donations to support seminarians in Sri Lanka. Donations will go to fulfill needs of seminarians so they can grow in spiritual, human, pastoral, & psychological formation in Fr. Francis' Diocese of Batticaloa. The Diocese of Batticaloa is a newly formed diocese. After years of brutal civil war and the disasters caused by tsunami, it has been very difficult to uplift the standard of living and find stable funding. The subsidy given by the diocese to run the seminary is insufficient and, at the same time, the contribution from students' parents is comparatively low since their income is very poor. The diocese is committed to forming future priests not only for their diocese, but also to serve as missionaries.
