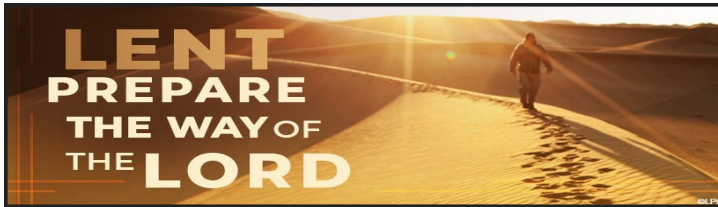
In Sympathy
