

St. Michael and St. John have been appointed a new administrator. Fr. Francis will complete his mission work here on June 30th. Our new administer will be Fr. Antonio De los Santos. Fr. De los Santos is from Naga City with the Archdiocese of Caceras. He has served as Temporary Administrator of St. Benedict Parish, Suamico, and St. Pius Parish, Little Suamico, Administrator of St. Maximillian Kolbe Parish, Sobieski, and St. Patrick Parish, Green Bay. He most recently served as Administrator of Annunciation Blessed Virgin Mary, St. Jude and St. Joseph parishes in Green Bay. His appointment is effective July 1, 2024.
