 The Solemnity of Pentecost, The Solemnity of The
 Most Holy Trinity, The Solemnity of The Most
 Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ (Corpus
 Christi), The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ,
 King of the Universe.
- First Holy Communion (Only First Communicants)
- Wedding Mass (Only Bride and Groom)
- The Mass celebrating the patronal feast of each oratory, church, parish, or mission
- The anniversary Mass celebrating the dedication of each church
